#### 2015 J109 NORTH AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP

The 2015 North Americans at Block Island Race Week has 24 J109s on the scratch sheet already and there are a few more boats who will probably enter. If you sail in another region, there may be loner boats available. Compensation could be hauling/doing a bottom job, bringing your own sails, and owner sails with you. Please contact me if interested

Because it is a championship event, rule 6.2 applies: total crew weight (excluding skipper) shall not exceed 1213lbs

Rick Hanson (class measurer) will be sending out time slots for class compliance checks as we get closer to the date (e.g. lifeline tension, sail tags & all other class requirements met)

Bob Schwartz has graciously offered his rental house "Crew's Hideout" again for the class party and as in past years every boat will be responsible for bringing/doing something

Dockage may be a problem this year because Block Island Boat Basin has lost its lease and it is undetermined as of now when or to whom to send reservations requests. The center of the regatta is the Boat Basin and I think docking is much better than mooring or anchoring in the crowded harbor

<u>Suggested dockage strategies</u>: 1) follow Rick Lyall's lead and send an email to the BI Chamber of Commerce stating you want to receive contact information for the Boat Basin as soon as things are sorted out (send to Molly O'Neill at <u>bichamber@yahoo.com</u>); 2) white out parts of your 2013 Boat Basin form and mail it into their old address with a check for \$1,000; 3) reserve dockage at Champlin's or Payne's docks and remember to cancel it later (Champlin's has a 100% refund policy & can reserve on



the web; Payne's is closer but is old school: call Cliff Payne at <u>401-466-5572</u>, let it ring about 35 times, chat him up, give your boat's name, ask him to write it down. He does not accept money or paperwork in advance so hope it works & call back in early June); and 5) put in your own bid for the new lease on the Boat Basin

<u>Both BIRW and Red Grant are championship regattas</u> and will be raced under class rule 6.2 (1213lb weight limit). All other east coast regattas are expected to be raced under rule 6.1 (6 non driver crew + 1 <=132lbs person)

The Intercollegiate Offshore Regatta Oct 10,11 is not a class event but it is supported by the class and generally gets a big turnout. In 2013 there were 16 J109s and in 2014 13 J109s.
